How can you participate?

We invite volunteers to obtain items on the checklist, assemble the Kits, and deliver them to Monarch School.

- Pack items in boxes. You may use multiple boxes, just be sure to label them (Box 1/3, Box 2/3...)
- 4 Contact our Volunteer Coordinator to schedule a date and time to drop off your Kits at Monarch School between 8:00am and 4:00pm Monday through Friday.
