WHAT IS THE MONARCH FARMERS' MARKET?

To support our families food needs, we have a monthly farmers' market where families and alumni visit campus and pick out fresh produce in a farmers' market style set up. We ask to have a group of 7-10+ volunteers to help set up canopies, tables, stage the produce, and assist with clean-up. The time frame for a farmers' market is from 3pm-5:00pm.

TIMELINE OF EVENT

- 1:00-1:15 - Arrival & check-in at the front desk.
- 1:15-2:00 - Set-up tables, signage & flyers.
- 2:00-2:30 - Set up produce and other items to distribute.
- 2:30-4:00 - Families walk through farmers' market and get their distribution & to-go boxes are made by volunteers.
- 4:00-4:25 - Clean up, fold canopies, collapse boxes at the end, make sure items get returned to Operations Room.

TIPS

- We are able to provide offsite parking a block and half away. Please connect with Zaira if accommodations need to be made.
- Bring sunscreen and some water! During the summer temperatures rise.
